

We are delighted that *Dinner for One* will be performed by Lyn Wainwright and Tim Myers, and that the cast of *The Real Inspector Hound* will feature performances by ECC regulars (Ailsa Higgins, Jonathan Goldsmith, Boff Muir and Graham Vincent) as well as some complete newcomers to the ECC (some of whom are treading the boards for the first time): Chris Yeager, Heli Parna, Kai Stolzenburg, Eddie Brannigan and Hayk Zayimtsyan.

The production's crew is also a wonderful mix of ECC regulars, many of whom are undertaking projects they've never tackled before, and newcomers. For example, we are delighted to have the wonderfully multi-talented Anna Holmén as our producer: one of the few roles she has never played in a production!

These two very funny plays promise to be as much fun for the casts as for the audiences. Tom Stoppard's *Real Inspector Hound* is a remarkably funny play, and in these early days of rehearsals we are having an awful lot of laughter as we grapple with the complexities of staging this fabulous play.

I don't think I'm going out on a limb to say that Tom Stoppard is a familiar name to theatregoers, but Laurie Wylie? *Dinner for One* is in fact an extremely famous play, and the original is screened on television every New Year's Eve. It is quoted in much the same fashion as people quote from *Monty Python*: but not in Great Britain! Devotees of this cult

work are to be found in large parts of Germany and the Nordic countries!

We look forward to welcoming you to the Warehouse Studio Theatre next March!

The Studio Theatre 6 & 7 February 2016


